Dear friends,

A very warm welcome to Our Lady Help of Christians.

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY We remember the influence of fathers in our lives, our parish and community.

We also thank God for the gift of our priests. They lead our Eucharistic community and through them we experience God's presence in the sacraments.

There is a horticultural theme to our readings today. The first reading from the Prophet Ezekiel and the Gospel both speak about starting a new plant, about sowing seed, about making something grow. Ezekiel takes the image of a tender shoot planted on a high mountain to describe how God will take something very small and make it grow into something that is strong, durable, and fruitful, that offers shelter and protection.

In the Gospel Reading, Jesus uses planting seeds to illustrate the power of God's word: once planted it must bear fruit. In the parable of the mustard seeds, the tiniest of seeds, it grows to become a large plant with branches so strong that the birds of the air can rest in them.

Paul reminds us that we are on a journey and our home is with the Lord in Heaven but while on this journey we must live by Faith. It is our Faith that guides our steps on the journey.

Like the seeds and new plants, the kingdom of heaven is about something new growing, in us and in the world around us. God is at work. Trust Him!
